My Office- Widgets

What is My Office?

- A tool to organize personalized components for easy access to AMANDA functions that are relevant to each user
- It is user-friendly interface to navigate through and query for information
- It has two components
 - Widgets
 - Apps

What is Widget?

- Widgets are the applications that are easy ways to automate specific business functions.
- Widget emulates the function of customizable Web 2.0 sites
- Like Web 2.0, widgets are mini applications, which are fine tuned for a specific purpose

- Functionality at fingertips
 - Capabilities of an application crossed with accessibility of an icon
- Personalized user experience
 - customized arrangement
- Self-contained architecture
 - If a widget breaks, others will not be effected



Widgets- Organization

- Users can subscribe to different Widgets.
- Administrators can grant access to Widgets and organize them in groups
- The user can drag and drop to reorder the appearance of Widgets in the desired location.
